In recent years, meetings and exhibitions have been increasingly affected by room block poaching. Poachers are businesses that actively seek to deceive, recruit or divert event participants, primarily attendees and exhibitors, away from official room blocks and into other hotel bookings. These businesses use a range of techniques to approach attendees and gain their business Today, poaching is increasingly extending beyond room blocks into exhibitor services, audiovisual, sponsorships and more. In 2015, a Summit was convened under the auspices of the *Events Industry Council*, from which a white paper, some excellent tools and samples emerged. This past spring, a second, more detailed survey was conducted providing insight to the current effects of the issue.
